World cities in 2021: Top 1,000 cities summary Nearly 90% of North America's GDP in 2021 was concentrated in 370 cities Middle class growth dominated by Eastern European and Chinese cities Necessity spending remains the highest among African cities Sustainability awareness sees most cities record improving air quality levels Passenger car numbers continue to rise despite the increasing focus on alternative mobility Rising unemployment is a challenge for emerging and developing cities Travel industries recover in 2021 but are still below pre-pandemic levels
